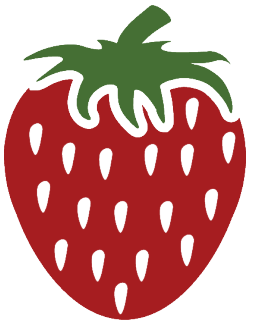

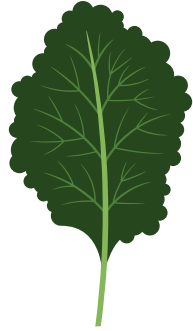

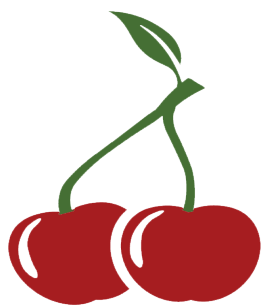

DIRTY DOZEN

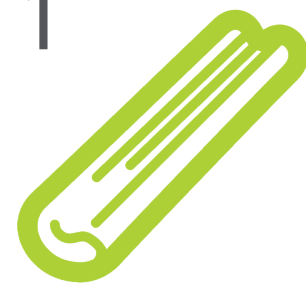
The 'Dirty Dozen' published by the Environmental Working Group (EWG) is a list of produce containing the highest pesticide residue levels. In 9 years, apples have appeared in the top three most contaminated items eight times and has been the most contaminated item five times (followed by peaches and celery).

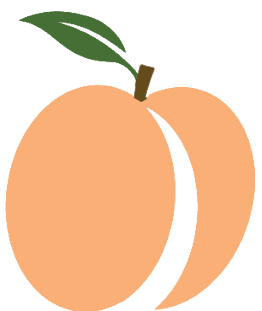

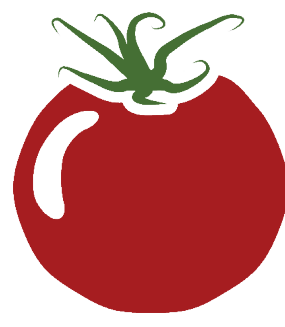

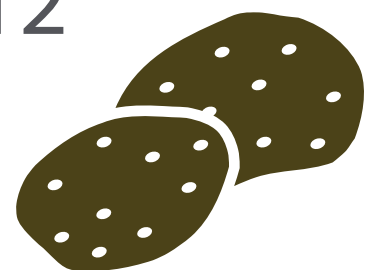
